- 4. In Accordance With ORC 121.22G4 - Preparing for, conducting, or reviewing negotiations or bargaining sessions with public employees concerning their compensation.
- 5. In Accordance With ORC 121.22G5 - Matters required to be kept confidential by federal law or regulations or state statutes.
- 6. In Accordance With ORC 121.22G6 - Details relative to the security arrangements and emergency response protocols for a public body or a public office
- 7. In Accordance With ORC 121.22G8 – Consideration of confidential information related to the marketing plans, specific business strategy, production techniques, trade secrets or personal financial statements of an applicant for economic development assistance, or negotiations with other political subdivisions respecting requests for economic development assistance.
